Craft Instructions

Sticky Tongue Frog

(Inspired by: kidsactivitiesblog.com)

You will need:

- Frog template
- Green construction paper
- Party blower
- Velcro
- Felt

What to do:

1. Print the frog template. Cut it out and trace on green construction paper. Cut out the construction paper frog. Fold on the dotted line. Cut a small V-shape notch in the middle of the fold.
2. Decorate your frog any way you like.
3. Push the blower through the opening. Keep the frog near the top of your blower so you can see the frog's tongue (blower) unfold. You may have to tape it in place.
4. Attach Velcro to the end of the party blower.
5. Draw some flies on the felt with a black marker and cut out.



Now you are ready to catch the flies! Blow through the party blower, the frog's tongue will unfold and you can try to catch the flies with the Velcro on the end of the blower.

How many flies can you catch? 1, 2, 3...
