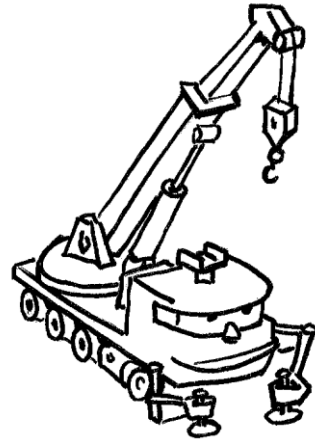

## Adjust signing style to fit the character

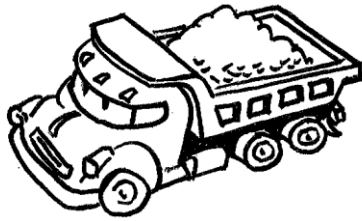
Subtleties of characters and differences between characters, which might be conveyed by tone of voice, are conveyed by the ASL storyteller through changes in signing style, body movements and gestures. For example, when Kathy describes the Crane Truck in this story, she holds her body upright like the crane lifting in the sky. But as the Crane Truck cuddles his teddy bear for bed, she softens her style. *Based on the Clerc Center's Shared Reading Project.*

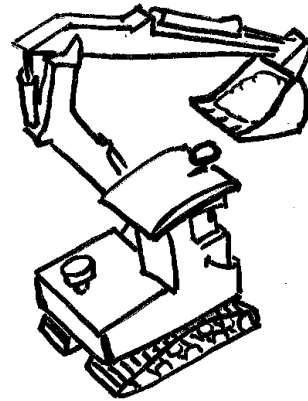

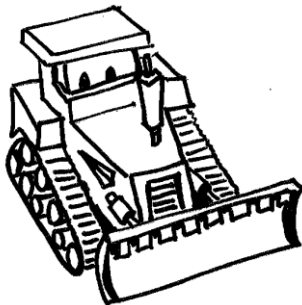
